**HIGHER COURT IN BELGRADE
-War Crimes Department-**

On the basis of Article 331.1 and 2, in relation to Article 43.2 (5) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, related to the provisions of Article 3 and Article 4 of the Law on the Organization and Competence of State Authorities in the War Crimes Procedure, I am raising an

**INDICTMENT
Against the following:**

due to the existence of justified suspicion that he had carried out the following:

On 9 October 1991, violating the rules of international law during an armed conflict, he ordered an attack on the civilian population that resulted in casualties, so that during the non-international armed conflict that existed in the Republic of Croatia, which was then part of the then Socialist Federal Republic Yugoslavia, between the Yugoslav People's Army, the Territorial Defense, militia, volunteer units on the one hand and organized armed formations on the one hand, i.e. the National Guard Corps (ZNG) and the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Croatia, on the other hand, as the commander of the 2nd Proletarian Guards Motorized Brigade of the JNA in the rank of lieutenant colonel, with the exclusive right to command all units of the brigade as well as subordinate units, and bearing full responsibility for the proper use of the units of the brigade with the right to demand their consistent implementation and control of the execution of the order, contrary to the provisions of Article 3.1 (1) a) of the Geneva Convention IV relative to the Protection of Civilians in time of war from 12 August 1949, Article 13.1 and 2, in connection with Article 4.1(2) a) of the Amendment Protocol on the Protection of Victims of Non-International (Internal) Armed Conflicts (Protocol II) to the aforementioned convention, ordered an attack on the village of Lovas and its population, issuing the attack order op. no. 9, Classified no. 350-1 on 10 October 1991, in which it is wad

stated that the main forces had blockaded the village and used artillery to attack the buildings in the village, while the auxiliary forces carried out a “cleansing of the village of ZNG and MUP members, as well as the hostile population,” which is contrary to the basic principles of command and protection of the civilian population during combat operations, whereupon the civilian population was not part of the armed forces and did not participate in the armed conflict, and on 10 October 1991, the forces under the command of the defendant, acting according to the above-mentioned order, attacked the village and on that occasion killed at least 7 civilians with firearms, including BA, BV, BG, BD, BĐ, BE and BŽ,

- thereby committing the criminal offense of war crime against the civilian population from Article 142.1 of the CC of the FRY.
