Background and general allegations:

At the time relevant to this indictment, an internal (non-international) armed conflict existed in the territory of Bosnia-Herzegovina (BH). Parties to the conflict were the BH and Republic of Srpska's Armies. Acting as a soldier of the Republic of Srpska's Army, the accused, AA, took the life of one Muslim civilian, thereby committing serious breaches of international law, as envisaged by the following acts and provisions:

- Article 3 (1.a) of the *Geneva Convention on the Protection of Civilian Persons in Time of War (Geneva Convention IV)*, in re
- Article 4 (1, 2.a) of the *Protocol Additional to the Geneva Convention on the Protection of Victims of Non-International Armed Conflicts (Protocol II)*.

Charges

In the afternoon of 26 June 1992, AA, armed with an automatic rifle and in uniform, was present in ..., municipality Accompanied by his accomplice BB, AA arrived in front of the house owned by VV. Having found him at home, AA pointed his rifle at VV's back and ordered him to move ahead. When they reached GG's house in the same neighbourhood, AA ordered BB to proceed through the house yard. Once in the garden, AA, determined to take VV's life, fired a short burst into the victim's head. Having sustained multiple fractures in the top and base of the skull including the facial and upper jaw portions, as well as a compound fracture of the right shoulder blade with multiple bone fragments, VV died shortly afterwards.

By his involvement in the above-described incident, the accused, AA, committed the criminal offence under article 142 (1) (war crime against civilian population) of the *FRY Criminal Act*.
